



POSTER CONTEST FAQ

Q: Why a Poster Contest?

A: The goal of this program is to increase the awareness of youngpeople’s faith, while encouraging them to speak to other youth “in their own language” about the true meaning of Christmas.

Q: Who is Eligible?

A: All Children age 5 – 14, Judged in 3 age categories

Ages: 5- 7; 8-10; 11-14 (Age as of Nov. 1, 2021)

Q: Is there a fee to participate?

A: No, however, participants must provide their own materials and supplies.

Q: It says this is a CONTEST, are there prizes?

A: Yes, A Winner and A Runner-up in each age category will be awarded a prize.

Q: Cool, What’s the Prize?

A: Have Faith, you’ll find out if you participate!

Q: What would I put on a poster?

A: The poster MUST reflect the theme of: *Keep Christ in Christmas*. Each poster should be the ORIGINAL WORK (including concept, layout, slogan and any visual images) of a single person.

Q: Can an adult help me?

A: Adults can help with getting ideas flowing and materials for you; but all work shall be by the applicant.

Q: How BIG can I make my poster? I’m thinking a billboard would be cool?

A: Posters should be approx. 11”x17” in size.

Q: Can I use something other than Crayons?

A: Yes, the poster can be color or black and white. Paint, ink, etc. may be used. IF for example if pastels, chalk or charcoal are used, the poster must be laminated or covered with clear plastic for submission.

Q: How do I sign up?

A: Get an Entry Form at the OLV Bazar, OLVCS, Back of OLV Church on the tables and get started.

Q: Do I turn in the Application before I start?

A1: No, complete the application **and affix** it to your Poster when submitting.

A2: The name and age of the person entering should be included on the back of the poster!

Q: Where do I submit my Entry Form & Poster? Is there a DUE DATE?

A1: Entries may be dropped off at the OLVCS Office, the OLV Church Office or in a bin at the OLV Activity Center - adjacent the Book Store doors.

A2: Yes ALL Entries MUST be submitted no later than 3PM on DECEMBER 16, 2021.

Q: What is the Criteria for Judging

A: The Judging Criteria is on the back of the Entry Form. 100 point scoring will be broken down with maximum points awarded for:

30 Points: Slogan– How clearly is the theme presented?

30 Points: Visuals– How do visuals convey the message?

40 Points: Overall Impact– How effective was the poster in capturing your attention and causing you to reflect on the topic?

Q: Will my Poster be returned to me?

A: No. Posters will become the property of the Knights of Columbus Supreme Council. It is recommended that you take a digital photo of your Poster as a keepsake or for future printing.
