I. ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible any graduating high school senior must have been accepted by an accredited university, college, or trade school as a full-time student and meet at least one of the following additional qualifications:

- The child of a member of Council 4678 in good standing can be from any high school from which we can get academic information
- The grandchild of a member of Council 4678 in good standing must be from the State College area or surrounding school systems

II. SELECTION CRITERIA

One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded. Scholarship selection will be based on a combination of high school academic performance, including college SAT or ACT test scores (60%), and participation in high school, church, and community extra-curricular activities (40%). The selection committee consists of Council trustees and the Grand Knight. The scholarship award will be paid directly to the student.

III. APPLICATION AND DOCUMENTATION (NOTE: The applicant may attach additional pages for each of the items requested in the application)

To be considered for a scholarship, a graduating high school senior must:

1. Complete the current (2025) prescribed application, answering all questions.
2. Attach a certified transcript of his or her high school grades.
3. Attach a copy of your SAT or ACT scores
4. Include a copy of a letter of acceptance from the trade school, college, or university. If an acceptance letter is not available at the time of application, the Council must receive a copy of the letter of acceptance before making an award.

5. All documentation must reach the Committee not later than the announced deadline for application.
